Extension for introduction to Bush Nippers

Participants will have the opportunity to get to know their peers during this activity. This will also give you a chance to get to know more about your students and build rapport.

'I went swimming and I brought' game:

- 1 Sit students in a circle. The instructor will begin the game by stating 'I went swimming and I brought a towel'.
- 2 The student to your right will then state 'I went swimming and I brought a towel and a ... (they will add an item to the list)'.
- 3 Repeat these steps around the circle. Students will add each item to their statement each time, making it more and more challenging.

'Get to know you' bingo:

- 1 Hand out a 'bingo sheet' and a pen to each participant, then send them off to find people in their group to complete their sheet. Students will need to write a person's name in the box that connects to them.
- 2 Each player can only use another person once on their sheet (depending on the group size, each person may need to be used twice to fill in a few more gaps).

Two truths and a lie:

- 1 Each participant will think of three statements about themselves, one of which is not true. Encourage some examples to be related to aquatic activities. E.g. I go the beach every year, I was born overseas, I swim twice a week.
- 2 Have participants take turns making their statements. The rest of the group must guess which statement is the lie.
